LEGO World Records: The Largest Caravan

So much so that you can go caravanning in a LEGO brick caravan.

The largest LEGO brick caravan consists of 288,630 individual bricks, and was achieved by Ben "The Brick Builder" in Brisbane, Queensland, Australia on September 26, 2018. Ben Craig was commissioned to start the design and





building process, while Caravanning Queensland and Top Parks got involved to sponsor the project.

The LEGO brick caravan was fully furnished with a stovetop, refrigerator, sink with running water, checkers board, drawers with silverware and even a tub of Vegemite food spread made from LEGO bricks. Ben once accidentally locked himself into his workshop and had to sleep overnight on the LEGO brick bed!
